Kindergarten

100-page composition notebook, wide-lined
3 plastic pocket folders without prongs
3 large glue sticks
1 bottle rubber cement (4 oz)
1 Elmer's Clear glue (9oz) for art
1 scissors that fits into pencil box
1 box zip top sandwich bags - if last name A - N
1 box zip top quart size bags - if last name O - Z
Optional: one computer mouse
