

## K-5 School Supply List 2024-2025

### Kindergarten

Welcome to Kindergarten! We are excited to have you in our class next year. This summer, we encourage the continued development of independence and problem-solving. Below are the school supplies for incoming kindergarten students:

2 pink pearl erasers
12 #2 pencils (sharpened)
4 Elmer's large glue sticks (.77 oz) - white preferred
2 boxes of tissues
1 box storage bags, sandwich size
1 box storage bags, quart size
2 containers disinfecting wipes
1 reusable water bottle labeled with your child's first and last name
1 backpack with a bottle holder (no wheels, please)
Sneakers for PE days (required for participation)
1 full change of clothes* (including underwear and socks) in a ziplock bag labeled with your child's first and last name to be kept at school.

## First Grade

Welcome to first grade! We are excited to continue learning and build upon skills learned in Kindergarten with the students! **To make school supply shopping easier for you, our first-grade team has decided to purchase all supplies this summer. Parents will be charged \$40 through FACTs. All school supplies will be ready for the students on the first day of school!** First-grade families are only responsible for the items listed in the table below.

While there is not a formal reading assignment for the summer, we encourage families to read to their children nightly. ## Fifth Grade

2 large erasers
5 Highlighters (one of each: orange, pink, blue, green, and yellow)

2 three-subject spiral notebooks

2 binders (3-ring, 1.5-inch)
2 sets of 5-subject dividers for binders
4 plastic pocket folders without prongs (different colors)
3 large glue sticks
1 bottle rubber cement (4 oz)
1 Elmer's Clear glue (9oz) for art
1 scissors that fit into pencil box
1 box zip-top sandwich-sized bags - if last name A - K
1 box zip-top gallon-sized bags - if last name L - Z
1 set of headphones or earbuds to keep at school
Optional: one computer mouse
